Miss Halson noticed the absence of white counterpanes in our dormitories, now that the plaster is repaired and the walls colored a clean refreshing green, we think turkey red counterpanes bordered with white would look very well instead of the dark and red print ones we have been using, and which are beginning to show signs of wear. May we venture to ask for some of these, and to add a little paragraph sent in by the matron about clothing SPECIALLY wanted for this winter:

Thick flannel petticoats, red or grey, for girls aged 12 to 17.

Winter vests, for girls of 10 to 12.

Dark aprons for older girls.

Dark pinafores from 32 to 38 inches long.

Flannelette chemises and drawers of all sizes for girls from $\ensuremath{\mathfrak{g}}$ to 17.

Flannelette night-gowns, all sizes.
