It was not caprice, it was not fancy or folly, it was their duty to preserve, maintain and consolidate the maxims of justice, equity and knowledge which they in their illustrious careers practiced and enforced. Look back through the history of the world! Is there any country in which there was civilization and freedom where the Profession of the law had not been honoured? and of the English nation they found that in all ages it has been upheld, honoured and respected, and, as Lord Coke said, it had founded a greater number of noble families than any other profession in the land; and why? Because as a nation they loved justice."
