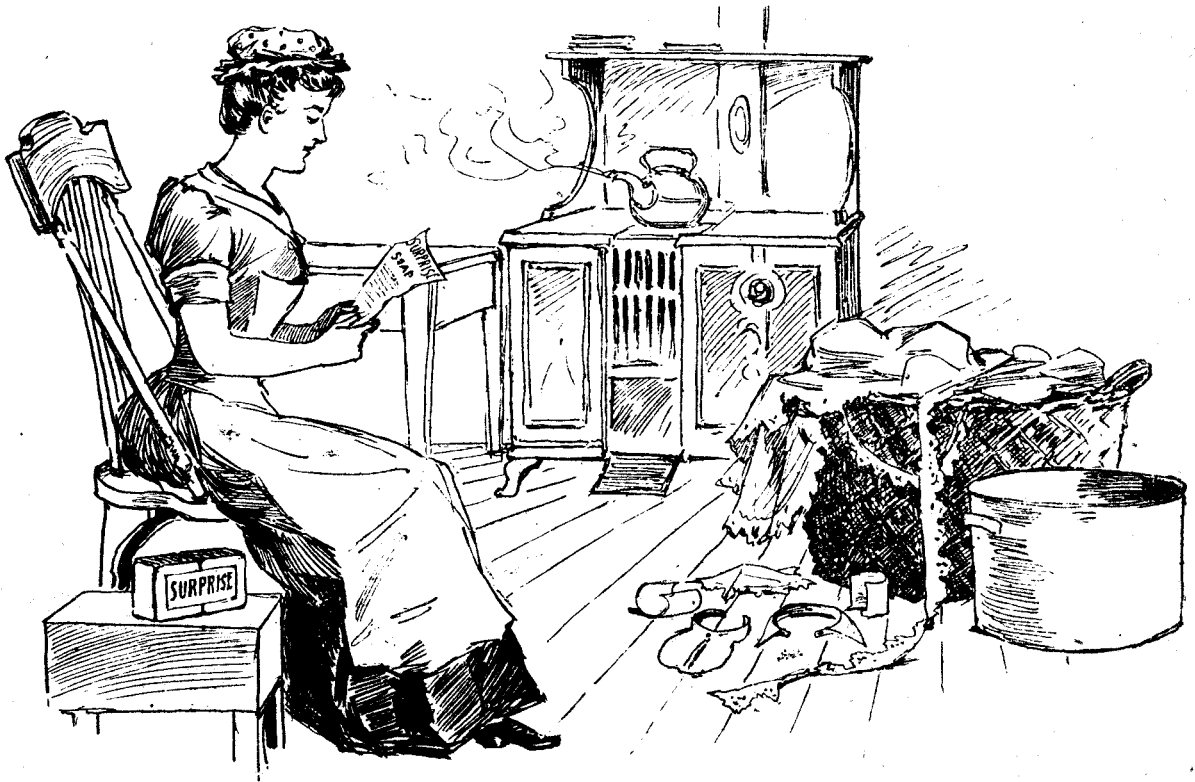


# SURPRISE SOAP
