Philo Alexin, who died in Lania the other day, at the great age of 94, had in his youth unwillingly contributed to one of the most terrible deeds perpetrated by the Turkish forces employed to crush his trade as a master carpenter. In his native town, when Omer Brion's factory over, the insurgents at Thermopylae, where he had taken several insurance leaders prisoners, among them the celebrated champion of Hellenic liberties, Athanasios Diakos. The fierce Moslem commander doomed that heroic youth to be spit on a wooden stake and roasted alive; and Alexin was required, on pain of death to supply the executioners of this barbarous sentence with all the implements needed for its fulfilment; that is to say, a spit of timber, fitted at either end with a handle, by which it might be made to revolve, and two stout wooden trestles provided with circular grooves, where in both extremities of the stake might have free play during the luckless patriot's martyrdom. On April 28, 1821, as soon as Alexin had completed the task imposed upon him, the Pasha's inhuman decree was carried out to the letter.

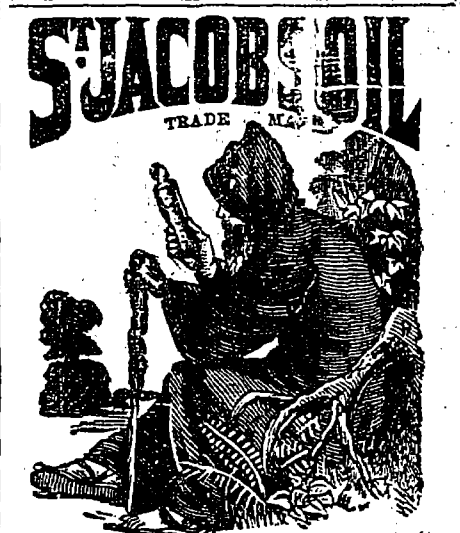

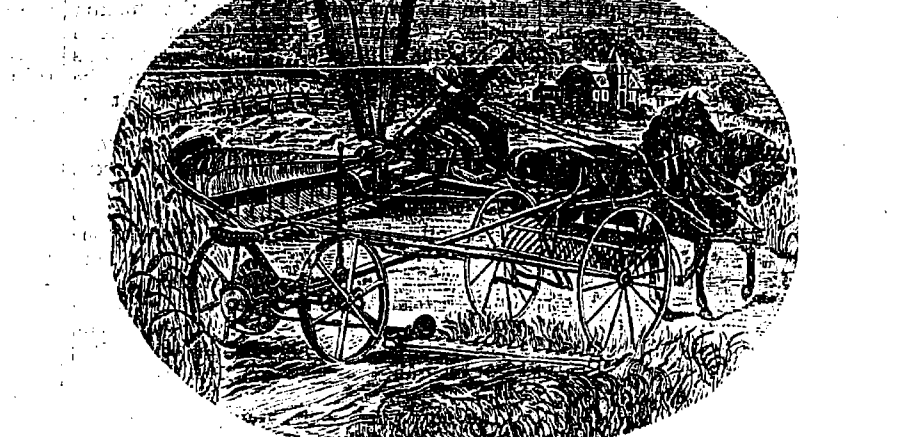

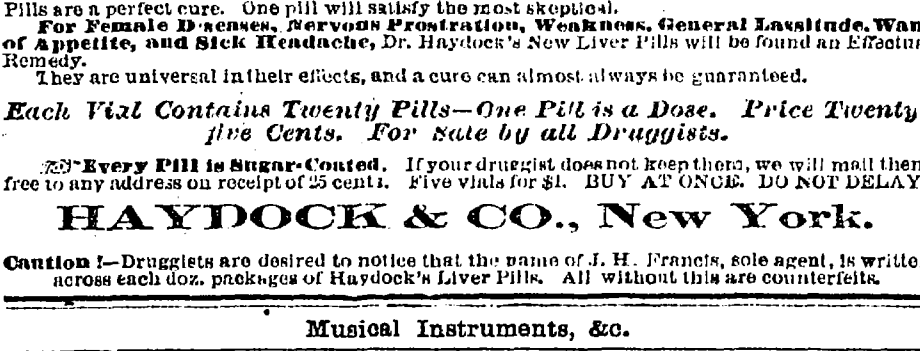
