

LLOYD V. STRONACH—MASTER IN CHAMBERS—JUNE 6.

*Venue — Change — County Court Action—Witnesses—Convenience.*]—Motion by the defendants to transfer the action from the County Court of the County of Huron to the County Court of the County of York. The action was for an account of sales of apples by the defendants for the plaintiff. The defendants swore to ten witnesses in Toronto, besides themselves, giving names and what the witnesses would be called to prove. The plaintiff swore to six witnesses in the county of Huron, but did not give names nor indicate what the witnesses would testify. All the transactions between the parties took place at Toronto. The Master said that, having regard to all the facts appearing, it seemed right to grant the motion and transfer the action. Order made as asked. Costs in the cause. D. D.
