

EXCHANGE OF NOTES BETWEEN CANADA AND THE UNITED STATES ON AMERICAN CONCERNING THE APPLICATION OF TOLLS ON THE ST. LAWRENCE SEAWAY

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The Secretary of State for External Affairs on behalf of the Government of Canada proposes that the provisions of the attached Memorandum of Agreement and the Tariff of Tolls set out therein shall be made binding by the two governments with effect from April 1, 1959. MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE ST. LAWRENCE SEAWAY AUTHORITY AND THE ST. LAWRENCE SEAWAY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION RESPECTING THE ST. LAWRENCE SEAWAY TARIFF OF TOLLS

The St. Lawrence Seaway Authority is hereinafter referred to as the "Authority" and the Saint Lawrence Seaway Development Corporation as the "Corporation". The St. Lawrence Seaway Authority Act, enacted by the Parliament of Canada, having provided, in part, as follows: 11. Where the works have been constructed and maintained to such extent as to enable the works to be operated by the Authority with works to be undertaken by an appropriate authority in the United States; the two deep waterways mentioned in section 10, this way be established pursuant to sections 13 and 14, or by agreement between Canada and
