Among the types of assistance envisaged under the program are the following:

- logistical support in the form of clothes, fuel, spare parts and communications equipment;
- food to be provided to personnel involved in project implementation;
 - increases in balance of payments support directed to countries experiencing these difficulties.

Regular CIDA monitoring and evaluation procedures will apply to funds used for this initiative.

In addition, increased support could be provided to train more personnel from the Front Line States through an existing military training assistance program currently funded by External Affairs and implemented by the Department of National Defence.

"Southern Africa is and will continue to be one of our priorities", said Mrs.Landry. "Canada will remain a strong supporter of SADCC and its efforts to advance regional cooperation and economic independence".
