

ORDER OF REFERENCE

That having been read, signed and passed, the same be referred to the Committee on Finance, and the same be reported thereon at the next meeting of the Senate.

Extract from the Minutes of the Proceedings of the Senate,
Thursday, May 2, 1890:

*Reference to the Order of the day, the Senate resumed the debate on the motion of the Honourable Senator Kelly, seconded by the Honourable Senator Muir, for the second reading of Bill C-63, An Act to amend the Excise Tax Act, the Criminal Code, the Customs Act, the Customs Tariff, the Patent Act, the Income Tax Act, the Statistics Act, and the Tax Court of Canada Act.

After debate, and the question being put on the motion, it was resolved in the affirmative, on division.

The Bill was then read the second time, on division. The Honourable Senator Kelly moved, seconded by the Honourable Senator David, that the Bill be referred to the Standing Senate Committee on Banking, Trade and Commerce. The question being put on the motion, it was resolved in the affirmative.
