

all other persons who may hereafter be associated with them, shall be and they are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate, under the name of "The Canadian Society of Civil Engineers."

2. The said Society shall have power to acquire and hold all lands and property necessary and required, in order to carry out the objects and purposes for which incorporation is sought, provided that the annual value of the real estate, held at any one time for the actual use of the Society, shall not exceed five thousand dollars; and the said Society shall also have power to sue and be sued, and implead in their corporate name; to make and pass regulations and by-laws for the direction and management of the said Society, including all rules that may be deemed necessary for the maintenance of the honour and dignity of the profession.

3. The said Society shall be governed by a president, vice-presidents and council, to be constituted in such manner as may be provided by the by-laws hereafter to be made, and the persons named in the first section shall constitute such council, until such appointments are made.

4. A meeting of the said council shall be held within six months after the incorporation of the society, for organization, making by-laws, the election of officers and the transaction of any other business that may arise.

5. The head office of the Society shall be in the City of Montreal, or in such other place as may from time to time be determined by a vote of two-thirds of the members of the Society.
