An Act respecting the River St. Clair Railway Bridge and Tunnel Company.

WHEREAS the Canada Southern Railway Company and Preamble.
the provisional board of directors of the River St.
Clair Railway Bridge and Tunnel Company have, by their
petition, prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth,
and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:
Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of
the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as
follows:—

1. Section 29 of chapter 87 of the statutes of 1872 is 1872, c. 87, s. 29 repealed.

2. The times limited for the commencement and completion Time for of the works of the River St. Clair Railway Bridge and Tunnel Construction Company are extended as follows: The works shall be commenced within two years after an Act of the Congress of 1900, c. 117, the United States has been passed consenting to or approving s. 2. of the bridging of the said river at the point mentioned in section 1 of chapter 117 of the statutes of 1900, or within two years after the Executive of the United States, or

other competent authority, has consented to and approved of 20 such bridging, and the said works shall be completed within five years after such commencement, otherwise the powers granted by this Act shall cease and be null and void as respects Proviso. so much of the undertaking as then remains uncompleted.
