An Act respecting the Atlantic and Lake Superior Railway Company.

WHEREAS a petition has been presented by the Atlantic Preamble. and Lake Superior Railway Company, hereinafter called "the Company," praying that it may be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said 1893, c. 39; 5 petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and 1894, c. 63. consent of the Senate and House of Commons or Canoda, enacts as follows:-

1. If the undertaking of the Company is not completed Time for before the first day of June, one thousand nine hundred extended. 10 and five, the powers granted for the construction thereof by the Acts relating to the Company shall cease and determine as respects so much of the said undertaking as then remains uncompleted.

2. The Company may for the purposes of its business,—Powers. (a) acquire lands, water powers, and water courses, and Water and erect, use, make and manage works, machinery and plant for electric power. the generation, transmission and distribution of electric and other power and energy:

(b) dispose of such surplus power as is not required for the Disposal of 20 purposes of its business, either directly or by converting the surplus power.

same into electric and other power or energy;

(c) locate, lease, acquire, work and sell mines, minerals and Mines and mining rights, timber and timber lands; and may develope timber. such mines, and crush, smelt, reduce, amalgamate and dispose 25 of the ores and products of any mines, whether belonging to the Company or not;

(d) acquire, use and dispose of all buildings, machinery and Mining plant. plant requisite or necessary for carrying on or operating the

said mines;

(e) acquire, erect, use, operate and dispose of buildings, mills, Manufactures works and machinery for the manufacturing of articles from products. wood, pulp, wood pulp, paper and other products from wood or wooden materials;

(f) acquire any exclusive rights in letters patent, franchises Patent rights. 35 or patent rights for the purposes hereby authorized and again dispose of such rights.
