forces at Camp Borden, same being wrapped so that they appeared to be Christmas parcels. The booklet contained typical examples of Communist propaganda, a few of these being:

"What is Fascism?" . . "Fascism is the savage rule of the most reactionary section of Big Business."

"Are there Quislings in Canada?" . . "Canada unfortunately also has traitors. One example is Premier Hyeburn of Ontario, whose defeatist statements undermine the morale of our people and give comfort to the enemy."

"Canadian Battle Hymn." "So shall come a world of wonder -- world of workingmen!"
