NEW YORK, Sept. 7.—While the close in Wall street today was irregular, an impressive fact about the market was the speculation in war stocks.

Exchange on London opened about half a cent under Saturday close, but a downward trend was in evidence.

Notable gains were confined to the changes in the market for foreign account, at least they were regarded because of the frequency of "future" offerings.

CHICAGO WHEAT PIT IN ANOTHER SLUMP

Export Orders Going to Manitoba Instead of to United States.

HIGHER VESSEL RATES

CHICAGO, Sept. 7.—Huge receipts in the northwest were largely responsible for sending the wheat market today to new low price records for this season's crop.

As soon as word came that fresh arrivals of wheat at Minneapolis and Duluth over the holiday amounted to the heavy total of 220 cars, it was a foregone conclusion that prices were bound to suffer a break.

Export orders for wheat appeared to be badly needed here, as well as at other primary markets in the United States.
