

Our *West-India* Privateers have taken ample Satisfaction for past Injuries, as *Spain*, in that Part of the World, gives them a large Field.

'Tis not impossible but some Ships have been taken by consent, in order to defraud the Insurers.

I submit it, if many of our Ships have not been insured by Foreigners.

On a Review of the foregoing Account, it appears that we have taken from *Spain*, from *July 1739*, to *July 1741*.

7 Men of War  
6 Galleons  
31 Privateers  
127 Ships

Besides the Forts and Castles, of *Porto Bello*, *Chagra*, and *Cartagena*, entirely demolished; and, that they have taken from us

154 Ships.

And, 'tis remarkable, we have not lost one *King's Ship*, nor above one or two Privateers.

Undoubtedly many Gentlemen could make out a more exact List, especially the *Insurers*
