

CATTLE SUPPLY HEAVY PRICE LIST DEPRESSED

A 10 to 20c Lower Market on the Bulk of Offerings—Common Stuff is Hit.

Receipts of live stock at the Union Yards were 151 carloads—254 cattle, 600 hogs, 20 sheep and lambs and 10 calves. The number of good to choice quality cattle on sale today was less than in many previous days, and that of the common to medium was correspondingly greater. On account of want of space on the common to medium, the market generally for cattle was heavy, with prices for the bulk of offerings 10 to 20c lower, and the common to medium being a few choice loads of London export steers, which remained about steady. Common to choice cows and calves were a rule than the heavy weights, all the common, light butchers' cattle and steers being cheaper, and at the close of the market there were 20 carloads still unsold, principally Liverpool export steers.
