At the death of his father, who was the proprietor and founder of the New York *Herald*, this gentleman inherited this valuable property, and has since obtained control of the entire Bennett estate. This estate includes the *Herald* building, on the corner of Broadway and Ann street, the Bennett building on the corner of Nassau and Fulton streets, the homestead at Fort Washington, and other property. He has a great fondness for yachting, polo, horse racing, and fox hunting. Notwithstanding this, however, he has always retained an active and direct management of his business. He resides almost wholly abroad, but is constantly in close communication with the *Herald* by cable. He is one of the owners of the recently-laid Bennett-Mackay cable, of which he makes free and continual use in transmitting news to his paper. Mr. Bennett has never married. He is now between thirty-five and forty years of age, and receives an income of \$1,000 a day from the *Herald* alone. Not long since a syndicate is reported to have offered \$2,000,000 for the *Herald*, which Mr. Bennett refused.
