## 6000 TROOPS IN FLORENCE

City Patrolled as if in Time of Siege Because Forty Trades Are on Strike.

## HUNDREDS PUT UNDER ARREST

English Church Set on Fire by Petroleum. But Flames Are Extinguished.

Florence, Sept. 1.—The employees of 40 different callings have joined the strike which began last Friday. The town appears to be in a state of siege. Troops have been recalled from the manufactory and from camp, and every square in the city is occupied by a company of soldiers.

Strong infantry and cavalry troops are concentrated in the city. Plenty of other soldiers are available should order be disturbed.

The summer exodus has left the town empty, and many inhabitants have left from the fear of possible disorder.
