

NEW TRACK RECORD AT SHEEPSHEAD BAY

Fashion Plate Covers 1-8 Miles
In 1.51 and Easily Wins Long
Island Handicap

SHEEPSHEAD BAY, July 10.—Fashion Plate, the racing favorite, easily won the Long Island Handicap, 1 1/4 miles, at Sheepshead Bay today, and in doing so made a new track record for the distance of 1.51. It is the fastest time ever made in a race of this nature, and the best of a second faster than the best previous time.

Fashion Plate broke in front, but was joined by Effendi. These two raced close together for a furlong, when the favorite broke away and being rated nicely in front won by five lengths.
