STOCKS FORCED DOWN IN VARIETY OF ISSUES
Virtually No Exceptions to Lowering Professional Pressure in New York.

STEEL UNDER ATTACK
General Trade Conditions Reported as Excellent - No Surface Developments.

NEW YORK, Jan. 29.—The week ended much the same as it began, with an excess of pessimism in which stocks offered only feeble resistance to further professional pressure.

On the surface there were no developments to connect with the depression other than a renewal of apprehension growing out of the relations between Washington and Berlin.

While mining operations on the McIntyre Jupiter are being prosecuted with all vigor, no pains are being spared to install the surface plant with as little delay as possible.

A deal is reported, has just been closed in Hallybury for the purchase of the Porphyry Hill property in DeLoro.

The Madisons-McDonald properties in DeLoro Township are again being held in suspense for examination.

WHEAT PRICES DECLINE ON VOLUME OF SALES
Foreign Purchasers Began Reselling of Grain, Forcing Depreciation of Values.

SETBACK AT WINNIPEG
Prospects of Enlarged Shipments From Argentine on Lower Freight Rates.

CHICAGO, Jan. 29.—Foreigners canceling spot purchase transactions and then turning to the selling side of future deliveries brought about a substantial decline today in the wheat market here.

According to a well-known authority, the reselling of wheat by foreigners was due to the prospect of a reduction in vessel rates and because of signs that speculators had been buying from the southern hemisphere to the consequence of the lowering of ocean freights.

Wall street also found encouragement in the president's preparedness to improve the situation by higher quotations for the wheat.

On the other hand, the indifference of investors and traders to these helpful happenings was in itself a cause of discouragement.

LONDON, Jan. 29.—Money and discount rates were easy today. American exchange was quiet at 4 7/8 % for cable transfers.
