Eclipses for 1817.

THREE will be but two Eclipses this year, and consequently both of the SUN, as follows, viz.

I. The first will be May the 16th, 2 hours 16m. in the morning, no part of which will be visible in the United States; but will be visible and centrally eclipsed near Cape Comorin in the East Indies, at 10m. past 2 o'clock in the morning of the 16th day, in Loh. $147^{\circ} 11'$ E. of Boston, and Lat. $6^{\circ} 53'$ N.

II. The second will be in November the 8th, 9h. 26m. in the evening, invisible; but will be visible and centrally eclipsed on the Island of New Guinea in the S. Pacific Ocean, in Loh. 145° W. of Boston, and in Lat. $8^{\circ} 8' S.$
