Mr. Robarts then moved, seconded by Rev. Dr. Lett, and carried unanimously—

"That the Lady Managers of the Orphans' Home and Female Aid Society be authorised to grant to Mr. William Reeves, a lease of the land on Queen street, on the terms agreed to on their behalf by the Committee of Counsel."

Mr. Robarts, in accordance with the notice given by him at the last general meeting, then moved the following addition to the Rules and Regulations of the Institution, which being seconded by Mr. Coate, was adopted unanimously—
