The above subscriptions were the result of an appeal made by our late Venerable Rishop at a meeting held in our own School-house on January 16th, and include the annual Parochial collection.

Towards the end of January the ladies of the Parish met and resolved on a further and more general effort in behalf of the maintenance of Mission work both in this Diocese and in that of Algoma. The Parish was divided into districts, which were thoroughly canvassed with the view of obtaining monthly subscriptions. The ladies met with the most encouraging success in their canvass —the very poorest evincing an earnest desire to give of their little. Subscriptions were secured varying in amount from five cents per month to \$1.50, and it is expected that the monthly receipts will range between \$40 and \$50.
