CASTRO GOES TO EUROPE ON A MISSION OF PEACE

Santander, Spain, Dec. 9—The French steamer Guadaloupe with President Castro of Venezuela on board, came in here today. It was learned soon after his arrival that President Castro will continue on board the steamer to Bordeaux, and that from Bordeaux he will travel overland to Berlin.

President Castro has come to Europe with the intention of settling all Venezuelas international quarrels. The general health of the president is good. The Guadaloupe came into Santander flying the flag of Venezuela. In addition to President Castro, there was on board his wife, his sister, Senator Cardenas, two aides, and three physicians. The mystery of the president's trip to Europe was dispelled soon after the Guadaloupe dropped anchor. The reports that Castro is critically ill, that he was deserting Venezuela for ever, etc., were speedily pronounced absurd, and it was declared that he came to Europe with the double purpose of being examined by European specialists, and to settle Venezuela's outstanding differences with foreign powers.
