The Hestia was launched in 1890. She was originally the Mary Beyts, but shortly after being set aftoat she was purchased by Donaldson Brothers and added to their fleet. She was a steel steamer, schooner rigged, of 2,434 tons net register, and 3,190 tons gross. She was 365 feet long over all, her breadth was 44 feet, and she drew 27 feet of water.

The Hestia was in Halifax this summer with a load of salt from Iviza, and Capt. Newman, her commander, made many friends here then. Capt. Ferguson, her former commander, is now on shore.

Not in many years has there been a wreck on that portion of the New Brunswick coast attended with such loss of life. With at least twenty persons drowned and a possibility of fourteen more being added to the roll, it is a far worse disaster than any that have occurred in the Bay of Fundy for many years. The last wreck which caused anything like as large a loss of life in the Bay was that of the City of Monticello, which was lost off Yarmouth nine years ago, when thirty-three perished.
