RECENT DEATHS

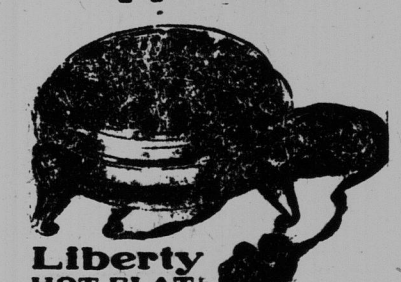
Mrs. Lena Sharpe.

French Woman Faces Death Penalty For Shooting Her Husband, Egyptian Prince



PRINCE AND PRINCESS

London, July 27.—A verdict of murder has been returned against the beautiful Princess Ali Kamel-Fahmy Bey, a Frenchwoman, accused of shooting to death her royal Egyptian husband in their luxurious suite at the Savoy Hotel, London.

The prince was found across the threshold of his room, with a bullet wound in his body. The princess, in a state of violent hysteria was taken to prison and locked up, where she had to be given a course of treatment before she became calm enough to answer questions.

Detestations who inspected the suite which they had occupied found that both the prince and princess slept with a revolver under their pillows. Witnesses testified that the pair, who were very much devoted to each other, nevertheless quarreled about every trifling. When their disagreements became so violent as to bring them to blows, friends always intervened, and in most cases the storms passed as suddenly as they had come.

Marie Marguerite Fahmy, as she is called in the indictment, is 32 years

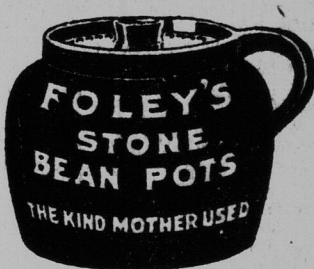
old, and her husband was a year or two younger.
