
IN TANGO CREPE

LA MARQUISE DE FONTENOY

Firing on the Nationalist Volunteers in Dublin on Last Sunday Was Illegal—What the Lord Chief Justice of England Said and Did in One Riot Case

Whatever may be one's views on the subject of Irish home rule and as to the respective merits of the Ulster Unionists on one side and Nationalists on the other, there can be no doubt that the use of the regiment of Scottish Borderers on last Sunday, against Nationalist volunteers in Dublin was grossly illegal, and that it had the effect of placing the government in a very awkward position.

There was no magistrate present at the clash between the regiment of Scottish Borderers and the Nationalist Volunteers at Dublin on Sunday. The Riot Act was not read, and the soldiers, who invoked the assistance of the troops against the Nationalists, was Deputy Commissioner of Police, Sir James O'Connell.

During the reign of Queen Anne, a riot occurred in London, near Holborn, and at the instance of some frightened officials, a large detachment of the regiment of Coldstream Guards was hurried to the scene.

The general, whose troops held Washington, was killed a few days later in a skirmish before Baltimore, and his son, in recognition of his father's services in the field, receiving from the crown a royal patent, authorized him and his descendants to bear the name of "Bladenburg" to their name.

Major Easton Loder's death is a severe blow to the English and Irish turf, for he was one of the best stewards of the English Turf Club, one of the most private which is the supreme tribunal of the English turf world, and also the ultimate court of honor for English Turf Club, and will always be remembered as the winner of the Derby in 1906 with Spearmint.

THE FORTUNES OF THE family were handed by his grandfather, "Honest Giles" Loder, who acquired great wealth by embarking in the tallow business in Russia.

When cooking apples add a pinch of salt. This makes them tender, and improves the flavor.

How to remove a scorch mark—Cut an onion in two rub the scorched part with it, then soak in cold water.

How to freshen a shabby carpet: Damp the carpet, a small portion at a time, with a clean wrung out in strongly salted water. Then rub dry with a clean duster.

Refining lard—Put the lard into a basin and pour boiling water over it. Let it get cold, then pour off the water, and repeat the process three times.

How to tint curtains cream—Mix a bowl of cream starch with a small quantity of white. Add a small quantity of the cream starch to the white before each curtain is starched.


