



LONDON PAYS DEAR FOR FOG IN HEAVY LOSS TO BUSINESS

Shops, Omnibusses, Cabs Feel the Effect of Heavy Weather; Cost of Lighting Become Huge Bur-

London, Nov. 5—(By Mail)—"C B.," writing in "The London Daily Mail," gives some striking figures on the cost of a London fog.

"To a big town fog is the most expensive of weather—more so even than snow," he says. "First comes the enormous cost of lighting. In London a day's fog means that the gas and electric light companies have to supply gas and electric power to a value of over £7,000 in excess of the normal requirements.
