

FRANKS MURDER HAS ECHO IN ARGENTINE

Mystery Enters Several Crimes After News Reaches Buenos Aires.

BUENOS AIRES, Argentina, Jan. 27.—Perhaps you would not think that the Leopold-Leob-Franke crime in Chicago would have much effect in the Argentine. But it has. The cable details didn't create much excitement, but when the mail arrived here there was a liberal publication of the peculiar theories advanced. Then split personality and ancestral mental weakness became apparently mysterious reasons for the actions of the Buenos Aires criminal element.

Lawyer Murders Another.

Criminal lawyers did oratorical assaults over every phase of Clarence Darrow published here, and crime went merrily on, but still without the proper intellectual background. It might never have reached any cultural stage to speak of had not a lawyer felt that he was about to lose an important case. In this emergency the lawyer, who was quite prominent, took time to think. When he had finished his deliberation he invited the opposing lawyer, who was glowing with the certainty of imminent success to dine with him. They felt well, and drank well and after dinner the lawyer invited his guests to a ride in a taxicab. They drove into the most stately and beautiful suburb and there the lawyer drew a monkey-wrench out of his pocket and demolished the opposition by beating his brains out.

That gave the necessary color to a superintending murder and has started a discussion of instincts, motives, inherited infirmities and super-charged emotions, which goes on to no conclusion.

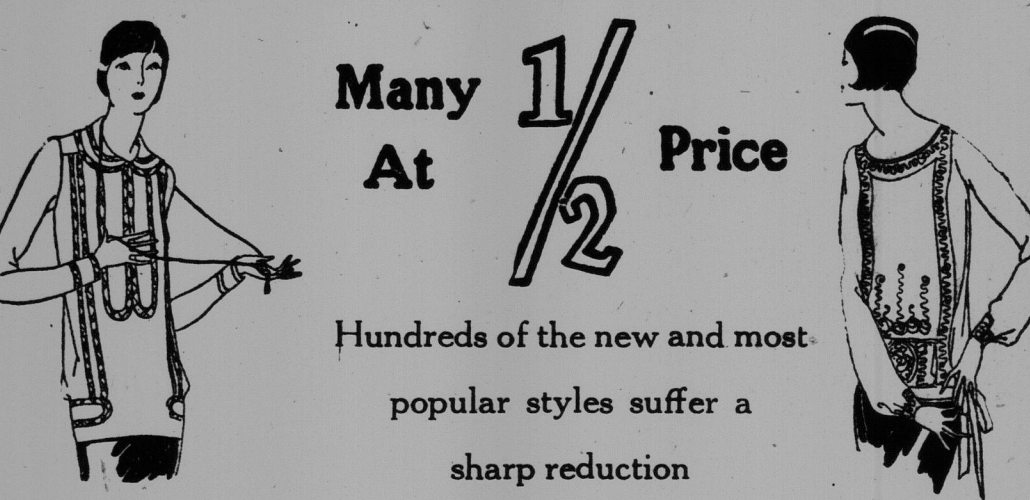
