

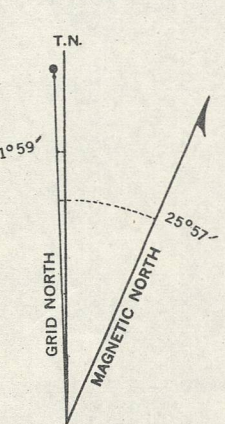

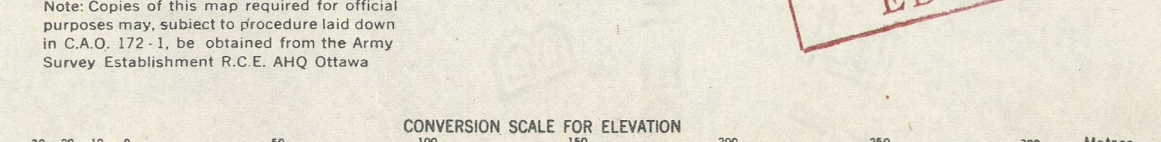
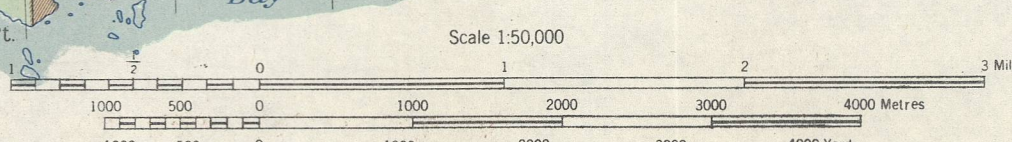
APPROXIMATE MEAN DECLINATION 1948

Take South edge of square (which point lies, and read the figure printed opposite this line on East or West margin or on the line itself on the face of the map. Estimate tenth Northward.)
