BILL.

An Act to revive and continue the Act of Incorporation of the Toronto and Lake Huron Railroad Company.

HEREAS by the Act passed in the eighth year of Preamble.

That for and notwithstanding any thing in the Act cited The said of Upper Canada thereby amended, or in any other Act to have been or Law, the period for the completion of any road the inforce from the expiration construction whereof is authorised by the said Acts or of the period thousand the construction whereof is authorised by the said Acts or of the period either of them, shall be and is hereby extended to the thereby limited to the 20 period of ten years from the passing of this Act, and the present time. said Acts shall not be held to have expired or the powers thereby conferred to have ceased by reason of the expiration of the period first aforesaid, but the said Acts and powers shall remain in full force, and shall be held to have 25 so remained from the expiration of the said period until the passing of this Act, and the said Acts shall be construed and have effect as if the time limited for the com-
