Canals:

Such as connect one Province with another, or extend beyond the limits of a Province, are under control of Parliament, 92 (10, a).—And such, also, as are declared to be for the general advantage of Canada, or of two or more Provinces, 92 (10, c).

Casting Vote:

Speaker of House of Commons has a casting vote only, 49.—Of the L. Assembly, 87.——(In the Senate, when the voices are equal, the decision is deemed to be in the Negative, 36.—The same also in the Legislative Council, Quebec, 79.)

Census:

To be taken in 1871, and in every tenth year thereafter, 8.—Under exclusive control of Parliament, 91 (6).

A re-adjustment of the Representation to be made after each Census, 51.

Charitable Institutions:

Are under Provincial control (excepting Marine Hospitals), 92 (7).

Coinage:

Under exclusive control of Parliament, 91 (14).

Commissioner of Crown Lands:

Has a seat in the Executive Council (Ontario and Quebec), 63.—Appointed, during pleasure, by the Lieut.-Governor, 134.——His functions and duties, 134, 135.

Commissioner of Public Works:-See Public Works.

Commons, House of :- See House of Commons.

Companies, Incorporated:

Such as relate to Provincial objects, are under Provincial control, 92 (11)——Certain exceptions specified, 92 (10).

Consolidated Revenue Fund : -- See Public Revenues.

Copyrights:

Under exclusive control of Parliament, 91 (23).

Courts: - See Justice, Administration of.

Courts, Procedure of :- See Property.
