I have the honor to represent to the Department that the present frame house on the Crooked Lakes Reserve is old and unfit for a man who has a family to live in, and as Mr. Instructor Williams has been transferred to that Reserve it will be necessary to make provision for a suitable building where he can take his family. I would therefore recommend that I be authorized to call for tenders for the erection of a frame house similar to that built last year for Mr. Instructor Tomlinson on Pea Pops Reserve with the exception of an extra room that might be added to make the building a little larger,
