

Amburstburg 31<sup>st</sup> June 1872

Sir,

I have the honor to enclose herewith the Annual Requisition for Presents, Provisions & Rum, Stationary & Blacksmiths Tools, also the Fall Requisitions for Presents, Provisions & Rum. You will observe that the quantity each Piece should contain, as well as each Sort of Nettles, &c. have been mentioned opposite, in order to have the quantity proportionate to the Demand, the Number of these Nettles usually contained in a Sort is Fifteen, and I perceive that in the Supply for this Year there are only Five, making a difference of Ten to each Sort, a very material difference in an Article so much required by the Indians, and to prevent a recurrence I have adopted this plan.
