Dear Sir:

I have your letter of October 23rd in regard to road work in the Qu'Appelle Agency, for which funds to the amount of \$800.00 have been provided in the Special Supplementary Estimates. On receipt of your letter, the following telegram was sent to Indian Agent Booth:

"RE EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS PROVIDED SPECIAL SUPPLEMENTARY ESTIMATES FOR ROAD WORK QU'APPELLE AGENCY PROCEED WITH WORK EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS BEING ADVANCED FOR LABOUR".

In connection with the above work, I regret to say that your letter of September 2nd outlining the work to be undertaken with the funds available in the Special Supplementary Estimates was not brought to the attention of the Department official handling the Supplementary Estimates.

I am today writing to Mr. Booth confirming the telegram sent to him yesterday and forwarding him an advance or \$800.00 to pay for labour in carrying out the work outlined in your letter of September 2nd.
