Dear Mr. Macdonald,-

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 17th instant, inclosing a communication from Mr. C. K. Sproule, of Pictou Landing, complaining that the Indians residing near his property are taking his wood; and offering to exchange land with the Department, in order to prevent the Indians taking his wood, and also to avoid contact with them.

In reply I have to inform you that Mr. A. J. Boyd, Indian Superintendent, will be instructed to investigate this matter as soon as circumstances will permit, and you will be informed of the result later.
