the resolution.

However, as to Solomon E. James' denial of any knowledge of the resolution, the Agent reports that the Chief as well as others declare that they are prepared to certify that he did move the resolution and the Agent vouches on his own personal knowledge for the facts that James was present at the meeting of the Band when the resolution was carried and spoke to him in English in very favourable terms of Jackson and supported the resolution by his vote.
