Gentlemen -

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 24th ultimo, inclosing lease, in triplicate, of lands in the Penynooos Indian reserve to James E. Vick for execution by the Department, and in reply to say that before the Department can consider the question of signing this lease, it will be necessary that the arrears of rental amounting to \$1,119.60, should be paid and also that satisfactory evidence should be furnished, that at least \$30,000 or \$10,000 each year, has been spent on the premises in accordance with the terms of the lease.
