does not state  
whether the right  
of way will interfere  
with the improvement  
of any Indians. The  
natural inference  
from his report is  
that it does not; but  
it is necessary for  
the Dept to be specifically  
informed on the  
point. Be good  
enough to procure from  
Mr McKay & transmit  
to the Dept the required  
information at the earliest  
possible date. If  
any improvements are  
proposed affected, ~~transmit~~  
a description of the same, the  
names of the Indians  
owning them ~~same~~ & their  
value, apart from the  
value of the land, shd. be  
given.
