MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRIME MINISTER C249201

A telegram from Chungking of June 24th, which has reached us through the Joint Intelligence Committee in Washington, quotes Generalissimo Chiang Kai-shek as saying that he has definite information of a Japanese demand that the German Navy should take common action with them and of a German reply that their naval forces have completed preparations.
