

Since the planes for which the spare parts were required were purchased from War Assets Corporation, it was recommended that approval be given for this transaction.

39. The Cabinet, after discussion, approved the Minister's recommendation and agreed that the proposed export be permitted.

Appointments; Board of Transport Commissioners;
Bank of Canada

40. The Minister of Trade and Commerce and Acting Minister of Transport submitted a recommendation for re-appointment of a member of the Board of Transport Commissioners.

41. The Minister of Finance submitted a recommendation for the appointment of a Director of the Bank of Canada.

42. The Cabinet, after discussion, approved the Ministers' recommendations and agreed that Orders in Council be passed accordingly.

UN Food and Agriculture Organization; Fourth
Conference Session; Canadian delegation

43. The Secretary of State for External Affairs reported that the Fourth Session of the Food and Agriculture Organization Conference would open in Washington on November 17th. Canada was a member of the Organization.

It was proposed that the government be represented by the Minister of Agriculture, as head of the delegation, with his Deputy Minister as alternate. In addition to government officials, it was proposed that H.H. Hannam of the Canadian Federation of Agriculture and C.J. Morrow of the Fisheries Council of Canada attend as industry advisers.
