O GOD, who hast built the iiving temple of thy Church upon the foundation of the Apostles and Prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone: Grant unto the work of thine own hands continual increase of glory and spiritual strength, and daily make thy people more meet for the eternal tabernacle of thy rest in the heavens; through Jesus Christ our Lord, to whom, with thee, O Father, and thee, O Holy Ghost, be honour and glory, now and for evermore. Amen.
