# BRITISH COLUMBIA CHARTERS.

#### BRAZILIAN TRACTION.

The June return of earnings of the Brazilian Traction Company shows an increase of 560,000 milreis in gross over the same month a year ago, but the figures are not as good as they were for May last, running 222,000 milreis behind the record figures for that month.

The June total is 7,642,000 milrels against 7,864,-000 for May and 7,178,000 in June, 1916, a gain of 464,000 milrels in the corresponding period this year.

The aggregate gain for six months of the current year to June 30 is 3,467,000 milreis.

The net earnings for June show a gain of 92,000 milreis over a year ago, but are slightly lower than in May. The aggregate net increase for six months is 1,381,000.

#### McKINLEY-DARRAGH.

In a few weeks the McKinley-Darragh will be treating 250 tons a day of mine run of ore. A little later the McKinley will start up the 250-ton a day plant to regrind old sands and treat by oil flotation. This will give a combined milling capacity of 500 tons a day, treating ore and tails running in silver contents from three ounces up.

A short time ago McKinley-Darragh installed a ball mill which was expected to replace 50 stamps and increase crushing capacity a few tons a day additional. The ball mill has not, however, come up to expectations on the hard ore, and is only treating 110 tons a day. Twenty stamps have been put in operation as an auxiliary to the ball mill and in a few weeks the fifty stamps will all be dropping.
