WINNIPEG MARKET LETTER

(Office of The Grain Growers' Grain Company Limited, December 11, 1916)
 Wheat—In spite of very bearish sentiment in American markets, also in the Winnipeg market at the first of the week, prices show a substantial gain over a week ago. Prices in the Chicago market dragged heavily during a great part of the week, on account of the congested condition of the railroads. The legal market the bearish sentiment was offset by a fair amount of buying by exporters and the Imperial government. There was also a good demand for cash wheat. On Saturday there was a sudden rally on account of evening up of speculative trade, bringing prices back several cents from the low point of the day. With the end of shipping on the Great Lakes soon, and the possibility of more ocean tonnage, the present freight congestion should be relieved and many look for a change in sentiment in the wheat markets.

Oats—The oats market has followed fluctuations in wheat pretty closely and prices show a slight gain for the week.

Barley—Prices are lower, on account of buyers having secured sufficient to fill their available tonnage.

Flax—The trade in flax has been moderate, with prices showing a gain for the week after considerable fluctuation on certain days.
