THIRD, intitled "An act for the better extinguishing Fires "that may happen within the City of Saint John," the number of firemen of the said City of Saint John, to be appointed by virtue of the faid act is limited to thirty-two, and that number is found by experience to be infufficient; -- and whereas it is fit and expedient to give all due encouragement to the said siremen, to be watchful and diligent in the discharge of their duty.

I. Be it therefore enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council: and Assembly, That the number of Firemen of the City of men of the City of Saint John, to be appointed by virtue of the said herein before recited act, shall, and may be increased and extended to Forty and no more, any thing in the faid act contained, to the contrary not with standing.

IL And be it further enacted, That the faid Firemen in addition to the privileges and exemptions contained in the faid act, shall also during their continuance in the office of Firemen, be freed, exempted, and privileged from serving upon any Jury, in the Court of Quarter Sessions, or in the Inferior Court of Common Pleas for the city and county of Saint John, or in the city Court of the said city of Saint John, in like manner, and under the same conditions and regulations as they are in and by the said act freed, privileged and exempted from the several offices of Constable and Surveyor of the highways, and from being compellable to serve in the Militia, except in cases of invasion or other eminent danger.

## CAP. IV.

## An ACT to provide for the SUPPORT of a LIGHT HOUSE, to be built upon Partridge-Island.

ATHEREAS it is necessary and expedient, that provision Presumber should be made for the support of a LIGHT-HOUSE, to be erected upon Partridge-Island, lying at the entrance of the harbour of the city of Saint John, for the safety of Vessels coming into, and going out of the faid harbour.

I. Be it enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Murit stall be een Allembly, That from and after the time it shall be certified under vised mader the state of the seal of the Corporation of the said City, to the Treasurer of Light House is the Province, that a Light-House is erected and used as such up-
