UNCLE SAM

Described in Prussian Chamber as One of Germany's Worst Enemies.

By Special Wire to the Courier. Berlin, via London, Jan. 19.—In the Prussian chamber of deputies yesterday Herr Von Heydebrand, the Conservative leader, referred incidentally to America as "among Germany's worst enemies."

"Germany," he said, "enjoyed the splendid feeling of being innocent of all the horrors of this war."

"I should not wish to bear the responsibility of the worst enemies, among which America must now be reckoned, because it prolonged the war for at least one year," he declared.

Discussing taxation prospects, Herr Von Heydebrand expressed the gravest concern at the probable burthen to be placed on the poorest classes and he feared for the independent existence of the individual states. Things already had gone so far, he said, that the taxpayers must consider a fifth, or fourth or even a considerably larger part of their income upon the altar of the country. He warned the imperial government against levying further direct taxes, but admitted that this matter was not unlimited. If direct taxes were placed upon incomes from property from all quarters, that meant peace and the impoverishment of the wealthier classes, he asserted.
