JOFFRE AN IMMORTAL. By Courier Leased Will. Paris, Dec. 19.—Marshal Joffre is now formally numbered among France's forty immortals. The victor of the Marne was made a member of the French Academy this afternoon. Promptly upon the stroke of one, Marshal Joffre arrived at the institute, crossing the Seine over the Fort des Arts, accompanied by his sponsor, Gabriel Hanotaux, and his aide de camp, Commandant Jourat. Great crowds had gathered along the route, followed by the Marshal—crowds whose cheeks were divided between the great soldier, the chief figure of the event, President Wilson who attended the function, and President Poincaré of France. The French President attended merely as a private citizen and fellow academicien.
