AT THE CAPE.—Capt. Andressen of the bark Valkyrien accepted the inevitable and ran up to Cape Tormentine pier last week. The Valkyrien is now one quarter loaded. Five large barks are loading at Baie Verte, Tidnish and other points on the Bay. Both tugboats are busy.

MASTER TEBRELL SINCLAIR the boy soloist sang in the Methodist Church Friday evening to a small audience. His voice is clear and sweet but not remarkably powerful. Mr. C. A. E. Harris of Montreal his regular accompanist was obliged to leave for home before the concert in order to keep his Sunday appointments and Prof. W. H. Watts of Moncton took his place.

SIX YEARS AT DORCHESTER.—Fred and Clarence Dolanay passed through Sackville from Amherst Friday on their way to serve a six years sentence at Dorchester penitentiary. They had pleaded guilty to the charge of entering and stealing money and goods from the store of Mr. A. B. Luby at Southport, and were sentenced to six years by Judge Morse.

SPRINGHILL STRIKE SETTLED.—The strike at Springhill has ended and a general feeling of relief is felt throughout the maritime provinces. The whole matter of difference between the men has not been settled, but an agreement has been arrived at, bearing upon the immediate causes of the rupture. The men who did the coal cutting objected to acting as laborers. They contended that men should be given work to carry proper when necessary, and do other unskilled work usually performed by ordinary laborers. To this the management was not prepared to assent and the work goes on.

MONCTON DOCK.—The meeting of electors of the city of Moncton held on Saturday evening last to consider the advisability of granting financial aid to the Moncton harbor improvement company was the largest and most enthusiastic meeting ever held to consider a town question. The meeting was practically unanimous on a resolution to give a city loan of \$25,000 on condition that the Dominion Government give subsidy. The proposition is to build a dry dock and wet dock at Hall's Creek which is by nature well adapted for the purpose.

SEVERAL AT AMHERST.—Edward Weeks 73 years of age, committed suicide Saturday morning by hanging himself from an unoccupied barn on the Nappan Road. He left the house at 5 o'clock and not returning a search was made about nine o'clock when his body was found with life extinct. He had been in poor health for some time and occasionally despondent. He lived with his son George. An inquest returned a verdict of "suicide while temporarily insane."

He was troubled about his daughter, Mrs. Chas. McKay, who is now in Mount Hope asylum.

DYNAMITE ACCIDENT.—Charles Small, a young lad, living with Thomas Rose of Rosaway near Digby N. S., found a piece of dynamite in a basket, where it had been placed two years ago, by miners and forgotten. This he placed on the ground and struck with a stone. The explosion that followed knocked him twenty yards away into a pile of rocks. He has since been in an unconscious state and will likely die.

CARGO DAMAGED.—The Alta which was aground opposite Aulac about a week got in to Sackville wharf last Thursday. It was found that a part of the cargo had been damaged by salt water in the hold and in particular about twenty five bags of salt, consigned to M.
