

### Spurt In Settlers Coming To Canada

Immigration into Canada during the months of April, May and June this year showed an increase of 83 per cent over the same period last year, and immigration from Great Britain in the same time showed an increase of nearly 100 per cent. The total number of immigrants in the three months this year was 40,952, as compared with 25,092 last year, and the total number from Great Britain in the three months this year was 22,553, as compared with 11,695 last year.

From the United States the total for the three months was 6,375, as compared with 8,425 in the same period last year. From other countries the total was 12,026, as compared with 4,972 in the same three months last year. The increase in June this year was 83 per cent over the same months last year May's increase was 89 per cent over last year's, and April's was 44 per cent.
