"After a proclamatic has been issued by the Licutenant-Governor of the Province of Ontario, declaring the prison buildings now being erected in the city of Toronto, and the lands to be used in connection therewith, to be the "Central Prison of the Province of Ontario," every coart of criminal jurisdiction in the said Province before whom any person shall be convicted of any offence panishable by imprisonment in the common jail for a period of two months or for any longer time may sentence such offenders to imprisonment in the said Central Prison for such period of two months or for such longer time instead of in the common gaol of the county where the offence was committed or was tried.
