People who have never seen a tornado or cyclone have very little idea of what the wind can do. It is hard to conceive of the amount of force that is expended and the manner in which it acts.

There are two varieties of powerful wind forces, the cyclone and the tornado. The former is a revolving storm, travelling along a centre of low barometer, where there is a white calm, the greatest force of the wind is found at the edge of this circle of quiet.

The area of influence may be from one hundred to seven hundred miles in diameter, and as a rule the smaller the diameter the greater the wind velocity.

The tornado is a local disturbance, often accompanying in the interior the progress of a cyclone. Sometimes the track of the tornado is limited to a few hundred feet, and it rarely has a width of half a mile.

The cyclone carries with it a velocity of as much as 100 to 150 miles an hour. It is a certain amount of force ahead of its track, and the acceleration of the wind is great at any given point is gradual.

The tornado falls almost without notice, and the indications are often so similar to those of an ordinary thunderstorm that only a skilled and careful observer can detect the difference.
